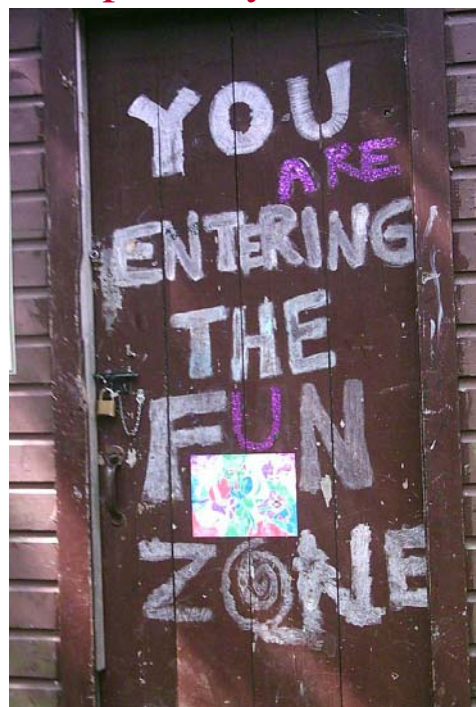
Rotarians have compassion and we care for those who are less fortunate. That's why we help them in our Rotary Service.
