was a DSG - a *District Simplified Grant* - money from your donations to our Foundation returned to you for our club project in Cameroon!

Speaking to us Thursday was Dr. Wayne Trebbin, director of the project and Keith Harris, an Ipswich Rotarian who is our District Foundation Chair.

Dr. Trebbin told us that for the 15 to 16 million inhabitants of Cameroon, there are only 2 operational dialysis machines - someone currently who is diagnosed with kidney disease essentially receives a death sentence.
