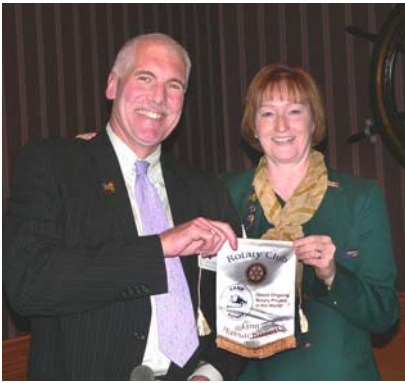
She told us about our district's Honduran community project for clean water, now nearly complete - we may have the opportunity to go to Honduras and volunteer to help finish the project later this year!

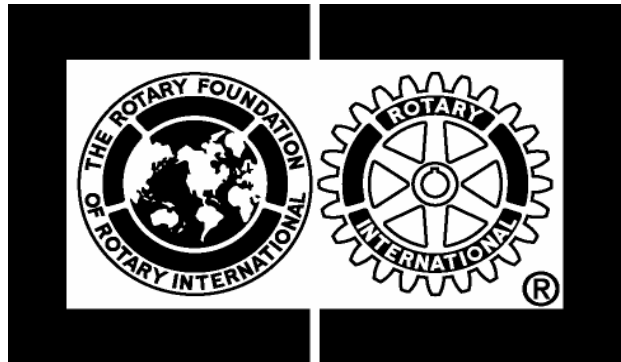

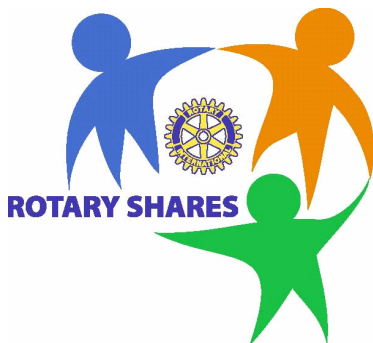
