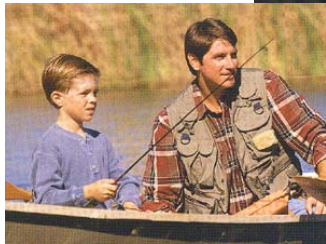


Our Speaker This Week

Ipswich Rotary Moves Permanently to Breakfast on April 22

President Bob Markel announced the results of a final poll taken of the membership. The results upheld a recent vote of the Board of Directors to make the club a breakfast club year round. **The poll results were 67% in favor and 33% opposed.**

On April 22, Ipswich Rotary will become a breakfast club after 87 years as a lunch club. This move reflects the changes that have taken place in our society and, as recommended by the Board, represent the best long term interests of their club.
