was our featured speaker Thursday - what an outstanding presentation! Claire is the Metro Boston Director of *Straight Ahead Ministries* whose local office is at 25 Munroe Street in Lynn.

She has been working with incarcerated youth, adults and the homeless for 23 years and is the founding and senior pastor of House of Hope Church and Ministry Center of Lynn reaching homeless youth, adults and former gang members. Her ministries were selected as a national



demonstration site for Best Practices for incarcerated youth from 2004-2007 and recently awarded a grant with the Essex County Sheriffs Department as a national demonstration site serving incarcerated youth from Lynn who are in prison in Middleton.

With her was a guest speaker and a former youth who has learned through the program how to become a leader himself and will soon have a college degree and will work with youth who in their earlier lives were gang members and now have learned to study, go forward. Jeron and Claire have found that "every youth has the potential to change!"
