Youth Service Managers to accept the bid of Hebb Construction, Inc. to build our 6 replacement cabins, Dave pointed out that with our new format of TWO councilors in each cabin rather than the former single councilor, new cabins are being built slightly larger than the models of 20 years ago.

He then introduced Brian Magrane, president of Youth Service Managers, to explain

some of the building details and to try to answer questions about the choice of the builder.

Several questions were posed from the floor including questions of why this and that details were not originally explained. Brian pointed out that on the initial bidding, the builder inspected the cabin requirements inside and out in person prior to making his bid.



The late bidder only went by the blueprints and thus had to add several thousands of dollars upon checking the requirements of the cabins internally and the various sewage and electrical interfaces at our unusual camp. The winning bidder had
