Pure Water for the World is organizing a trip to Haiti from October 24-29, 2011.

Below are some of the highlights of this trip:

- * Visit PWW's projects in Cite Soleil- poorest area in the western hemisphere
- * Tour PWW's filter factory in Port au Prince
- * Visit Croix des Bouquet-famous for Haitian artwork
- * Travel to rural areas to view PWW's work outside of PAP
- * Hands on work- Installing filters at nearby schools/ homes or other locations, working at the filter factory and assisting schools with building and/or repairs

Cost: In country cost (not including flight to and from Port au Prince) is approximately \$900 per person. This includes meals, lodging at a guest house, and on ground transportation. Travelers purchase their airline tickets, but Pure Water will coordinate flights to ensure you will be greeted at the airport.

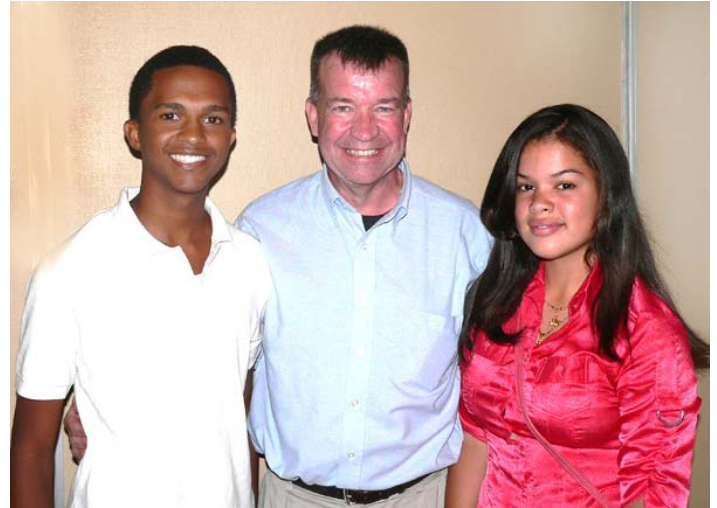
There will be 12 available spots for this trip. A \$450 deposit is required by September 1 to reserve a spot. The balance due must be paid prior to departure. Make checks payable to Pure Water for the World, and mail to the address below. Please note that the funds are for the Haiti trip.
