

Club Welcomes Governor Ingrid !



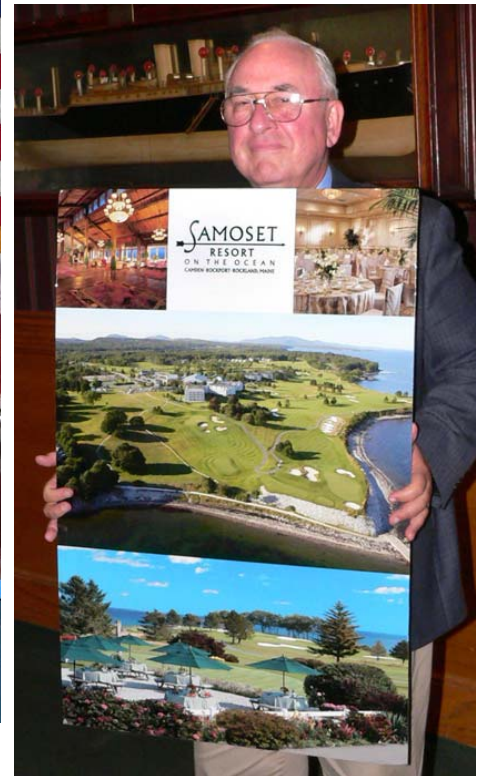
Ingrid Brown
