These snapshots were taken last summer at camp. Our kids LOVE our camp!

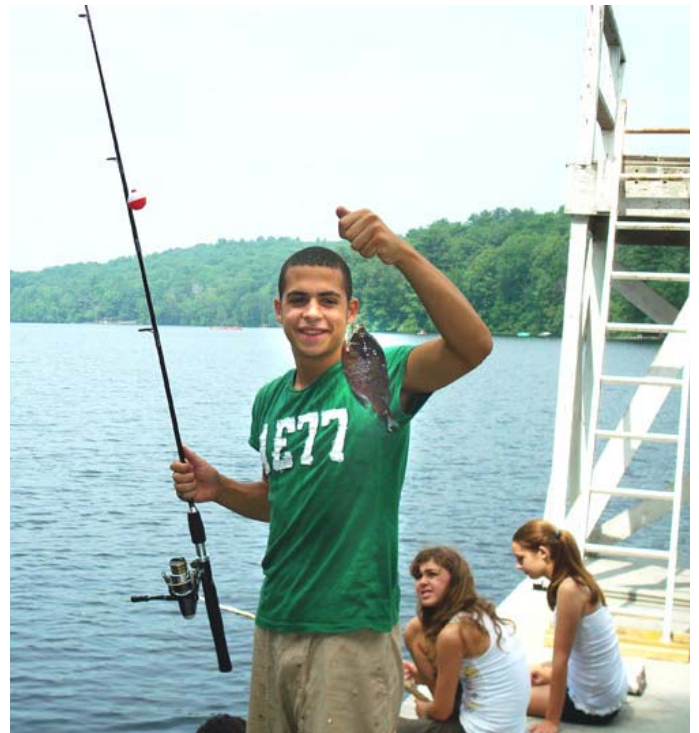

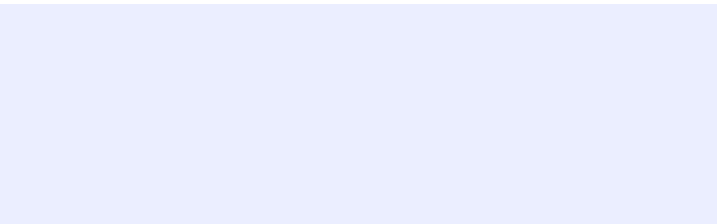
Rotary's New YouTube Channel
