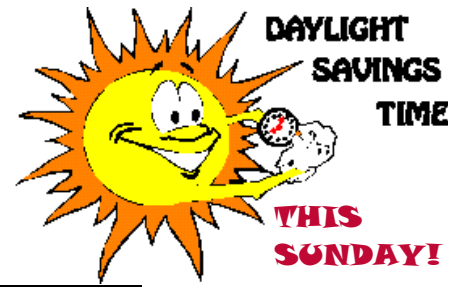

Raining Golf Balls?

Golfers did a double-take when they saw golf balls falling from the sky above the driving range at Biltmore Golf Course in Coral Gables, Florida, on 31 October. A helicopter dropped the balls, 1,820 in all, from 100 feet above a flagged golf pin in the middle of the range as part of a fundraiser in support of Rotary's US \$200 Million Challenge.



Rotarians in District 6990 (Grand Bahama Island, Bahamas; part of Florida) paid \$25 each for raffle tickets that corresponded to the numbered golf balls. Prize winners were determined by matching the numbers on the golf balls closest to the pin with numbers on the tickets.

"The first prize winner received a trip for two to Argentina donated by a Rotarian, the second prize winner received a Cartier watch, and the third prize winner received a weekend stay and brunch at a local Hyatt Regency," says District 6990 PolioPlus chair Noelle Galperin.

The effort netted \$45,000 toward the district's 2008-09 commitment of \$50,000 to Rotary's challenge.

"District 6990 plans to hold the fundraiser again next year and looks forward to topping this year's ticket sales," Galperin says.

Landmarks lit up with End Polio Now message

The Sydney Opera House in Australia was illuminated with an End Polio Now message February 23rd. The message was projected onto a number of iconic landmarks worldwide in honor of Rotary's 104th anniversary.

A number of landmarks, including the British Parliament, the Colosseum, and the Sydney Opera House, provided a dramatic backdrop for an equally dramatic message: End Polio Now.

Those three words -- Rotary's pledge to rid the world of the crippling childhood disease -- were projected onto each structure.

"By illuminating these historic landmarks with our pledge to end polio, Rotary clubs are announcing to the world that we will not stop until the goal is achieved," says Jonathan Majiyagbe, Rotary Foundation trustee chair. "We hope people everywhere will see these words, either in person or through the media, and join with us and our partners in this historic effort to rid the world of polio once and for all."
